First O antiphon: "O Sapientia"

*O Wisdom, coming forth from the mouth of the Most High,
reaching from one end to the other,
mightily and sweetly ordering all things:
Come and teach us the way of prudence.*

You, O Wisdom, bring everything into holy order, for You come from the Eternal Father. Thou dost penetrate all things and, by Thy strength and gentleness, dost restore the divine order.

You, O Eternal Father, send the One *"in whom are hidden all the treasures of wisdom and knowledge"* (Col 2:3). To meet Him, to open oneself to His love, is to be touched by Wisdom.

Wisdom, the tasty knowledge, is sweet as honey in the mouth and a burning fire of love in the heart.

It will never depart, as long as we remain faithful to Him, the Sun of salvation.

His words are life; His words are truth; His words are the way through the darkness. He is the light that shines in the darkness! (Jn 1:5)
